PRESCHOOL PLAN & RESPONSE TO COVID-19

All procedures are in compliance with the CDC guidelines for schools & child care centers.

STUDENT & PARENT PROCEDURES

- If any student/staff member /parent has a fever of 100°F or higher, he/she is not permitted in the building.
- Parents will wait with student outside the front doors and a staff member will come and take temperature.
- Staff members only will sign a child in/out (extended day).
- Face coverings are optional for students and staff during the school day.
- Parents are only permitted inside of the building in case of emergency.
 - If a parent enters the building, a face covering is required, temperature will be taken, & hands must be washed/sanitized immediately.
- As soon as the student arrives, he/she must wash hands.
- Student's temperature will be taken throughout the day.
- If a student shows any signs of illness throughout the school day, it is at the staff's discretion to send him/her home (even without fever). We cannot be too cautious in this area.

AMPLIFIED SANITIZATION

- All toys are cleaned with a bleach-water solution at the end of each school day. Once toys are played with for a designated time, they are put away until they can be cleaned.
- Restrooms (toilets, faucets, counter spaces, etc...) are cleaned with a bleach-water solution multiple times throughout the day.
- Students are taken to wash hands about every hour.
- High contact areas (doorknobs, light switches, surfaces, chairs, etc...) are cleaned with a bleach-water solution multiple times throughout the day.
- All nap mats are cleaned daily.
- Use of shared objects will be limited and/or cleaned in between.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

- During chapel, students will be distanced an appropriate amount of space during worship.
- In the classroom, when working at tables, students will be spread apart in their chairs an appropriate distance.
- During nap time, all nap mats are spread 6 feet apart.
 - Nap materials must be brought in a reusable bag. This is so they can be where they cannot touch another student's nap materials while being stored during the week.
- During play time, staff will make the most effort to keep students an appropriate distance apart.
- Classes will be kept to a smaller size in proportion to social distancing requirement.

ONLINE LEARNING INTEGRATION

- FCA will utilize A Beka ProTeach online (for PreK and above) for ease of transition should our classes be required to go virtual.
- All classes (Preschool 2's through High School) will utilize Microsoft Teams for online learning and parent/teacher/student communication.
